It is within three and a-half miles of Lake Ontario, and one hour by rail from Lake Erie.

Half-an-hour by rail, or one and a-half over a good road, will convey the lover of picturesque scenery to the Falls of Niagara, passing, en route, the New Welland Canal—the greatest Canal work in the world.

Other points of interest are the Pelham Heights, the Cascades of Glen Elgin, DeCew Falls, Queenston Heights, Brock's Monument, the old Town of Niagara, and the beautiful shores of Lakes Ontario and Erie.

The surrounding country called "THE GARDEN OF CANADA," is noted for the abundance of grapes, peaches, pears and other fruits.

Comfortable carriages, with careful drivers, can be obtained at very moderate rates.

The large grounds of the Hotel are planted with trees, vines, shrubs, etc. Lawns for Tennis, Archery, Croquet, etc.
