SIR.

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 16 November and to confirm the willingness of His Majesty's Government in the Union South Africa to facilitate the conclusion of a Trade Agreement between Canad and the United States of America by consenting to modifications in certain marginal preferences guaranteed under the Canada-South Africa Trade Agree ment of 1932, as set out in your letter under reply.

I further beg to confirm the understanding that the modifications effected in the Canada-South Africa Trade Agreement will be taken into co sideration when this Agreement comes up for revision.
