Dear Madame Minister:

I refer to recent discussions between representatives of the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Canada concerning the terms and conditions for cooperation between the U.S. National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the Canadian Space Agency (CSA) in connection with the space shuttle flight of the CANEX-2 payload.

I propose that cooperation between the two governments on this project shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Memorandum of Understanding concluded on March 31, 1992 between NASA and CSA.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of Canada, I propose that this Note, including the attached Memorandum of Understanding, which is equally authentic in English and French, and your Note in reply shall constitute an agreement between the two governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply, effective March 31, 1992, and shall remain in force until the termination of the Memorandum of Understanding, in accordance with the terms thereof.
