MONT-LAURIER-SENNETERRE HIGHWAY

Mr. LALONDE:

1. Has the federal government contributed to the construction of the Mont-Laurier-Senneterre highway, known as project No. 17-36? If so, for what amounts, and on what date or dates were the payments made?

2. Has the federal government also contributed to the work of project No. 58 (Villemare creek bridge to Mont-Laurier), and, if so, for what amounts, upon what dates were payments made for said work, and what were the amounts?

Mr. ROGERS:

1. Project No. 17 of schedule "C" to the agreement entered into between the dominion and the province of Quebec under the provisions of the Unemployment Relief and Assistance Act, 1936, provided for a dominion

contribution of \$70,350, being 50 per cent of the total estimated cost of clearing, preliminary works and gravelling on the Mont-Laurier-Senneterre highway, it being provided that the province contribute an amount equal to that contributed by the dominion. Payment of accounts rendered by the province with respect to this project were made on the dates and in the amounts hereunder mentioned.

2. Project No. 58 of schedule "C" to the agreement referred to in No. 1 above provided for a dominion contribution of \$5,000, being 50 per cent of the total estimated cost of bridging Villemare brook, including approaches, at Mont-Laurier, it being provided that the province contribute an amount equal to that contributed by the dominion. Pay-
