The consonants are sounded as in English; there is but one explosive sound, *kw*, not heard in European languages. *tc* represents the sound of *ch* in church, as in Powell's alphabet, adopted by the Smithsonian Institution, and is the more easily recognized, as there is no *c*, its place being taken by *k*.
