

CARPENTER AND JOINER.—Blue Navy Cap, Blue Jacket with five Company's buttons, gold cross Axes on left sleeve for Carpenter, and single Axe for Joiner.

QUARTER-MASTERS :—

Blue Navy Serge Jumper, with Company's Badge.

White Drill Navy Jumper, with Company's Badge.

Flannel Singlet, Navy pattern.

Black Neck Handkerchief.

Company's Cap and Ribbon.

Pair Blue Serge Trousers, Navy pattern.

Pilot Cloth Jacket.

These Uniforms are supplied by the Company, free of cost after six months' service, to the Quarter-Masters; Jackets are also given to Look-out men after similar service.

ABLE SEAMEN AND ORDINARY SEAMEN.—Guernsey, Man-of-War cap, with Ribbon, having ship's name in gold thread; Blue Serge Trousers; Blue Dungaree Working Suits, Jacket and Trousers.

Guernseys, Man-of-War Caps, Ribbons, Serge Trousers and Jackets and Blue Dungaree Working Suits can be purchased on board the Ship. It is compulsory for crew to wear them.

CHIEF ENGINEER.—Blue cloth, double-breasted, same cut, standard of length, and number of buttons, Company's pattern, as Navy frock coat; cuffs trimmed with four rows $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch gold lace with purple cloth between.

SECOND ENGINEER.—The same, but cuffs trimmed with three rows gold lace.

THIRD ENGINEER.—The same, but cuffs trimmed with two rows gold lace.
