

ORCHARD AT STARR'S POINT

Starr's Point, on the Minas Basin, a few miles from the quaint little town of Port Williams, is not even a village—Starr's Point belongs to the family of Starr's—there are three brothers, and they have comfortable homes in this most beautiful part of the country, where they will receive summer boarders. In the Spring the point is one glorious orchard. Avenues of blossom lead to various beautiful places—amongst them the delightful sandy beach, with its storm-battered cliffs and caves, and the spars and wreckage which the sea leaves behind when its great tides sweep back from the Basin—while Blomidon, in the distance, seems to stand guard over all.
