H E R E A S divers perfons have heretofore petitioned His Excellency the Governor in Council, for Grants of various parcels of the vacant Lands of the Crown, in this Province, flating, that they, with their feveral Affociates, were defirous of becoming Settlers therein ; upon which, Warrants of Survey have been iffued for running the outlines of feveral Townfhips, as fpecified in various Petitions: AND WHEREAS by an Advertifement bearing date the 16th of October laft, inferted in the Quebec Gazette,

Public Notice was given that all perfons having obtained Warrants of Survey, as therein mentioned, or meaning to apply for any fuch Warrant, should give in to one of the Commiffioners therein named, a lift containing the particulars therein fet forth: AND WHEREAS, by an Advertifement bearing date the 20th of the fame month, inferred in the Quebec Gazette, Public Notice was given that certain parts of the particulars required to be flated in fuch lift, would be difpenfed with : AND WHERE-As a few only of the Applicants have hitherto complied with the tenor of the faid Advertifements, and feveral other perfons have lately petitioned His Excellency the Governor in Council, for Grants of fome of the Townships, for which Warrants of Survey have been ordered : PUBLIC NOTICE is therefore now given to all Perfons who have obtained Warrants of Survey, or Orders of His Excellency the Governor in Council, for any part of His Majefty's ungranted Lands in this Province, to comply with the requirements contained in the faid Advertifements, on or before firft day of August next; and that in default of such compliance, they will be conndered by Government to have relinguished their Pretentions under any order of Council, or Warrant of Survey that may have been directed in confequence; and that His Excellency the Governor in Council will, thereafter, proceed upon fuch fublequent **Petitions as may have been prelented for Grants of the fame Townships.**
