- ART. 4. This meeting shall revise the Church roll, as submitted by the Pastor, Deacons, and Clerk.
- ART. 5. The Treasurer shall, at this meeting, present a balance sheet, signed by the Auditors after they have audited his accounts.
- ART. 6. In the event of any of the above offices becoming vacant, by death, removal, or otherwise, the Church shall, within three months and after one month's notice has been given, elect by ballot, without nomination, a member for the term appertaining to the said vacant position.
- ART. 7. A majority of all votes cast shall be necessary to a choice in all elective positions.

SUB-SECTION 3.

SPECIAL MEETINGS.

ART. 1. At special meetings no other business than that for which the meeting is called shall be transacted.

SUB-SECTION 4.

THE LORD'S DAY,

- ART. 1. The Church shall meet regularly every Lord's Day, for the public worship of Almighty God.
- ART. 2. The ordinance of the Lord's Supper shall be observed by the Church every Sabbath; on the first Sabbath of each month after the evening service, and on the other Sabbaths after the morning service—a collection on behalf of the poor being taken up at each service.

Section No. 3-Officers.

ART. 1. The officers of the Church shall consist of a Pastor, Deaeons (one for every fifty members or fraction thereof), a Treasurer and a Clerk.
