British Government Will Welcome From Canada a Military Unit to Be Transported By Canada to Cape Town for Immediate Service.

Montreal, Oct. 2.—The Star to-night publishes the following special cables from London: "I learn that the British Government is to-night cabling to the Canadian Government that it gladly accepts Canada's loyal offer of troops for South Africa."

HOW VIEWED AT THE CAPITAL. It Would Be a Confession of Lack of Confidence in Britain's Ability to Carry Out the Boer War.

PARLIAMENT ENDORSED IT. The fact is that except for the unanimous resolution of Parliament, supporting the British contention in South Africa and assuring Mr. Chamberlain that the Canadian Government's sympathy with the Unionists and of her readiness to assist in the vindication of their rights, materially as well as sentimentally, nothing has been done by the Government at Ottawa to implement that expression of sympathy with the practical assurance of support.
