The members of the Kent County and the Wallaceburg councils attended the ceremony, after which the county men were the guests of the Wallaceburg council at a banquet at the Hotel Dupont.

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RELIEVES PAIN

ARMENIA SIGNS A TREATY WITH KEMAL'S TURKS

Report Says Territory Will Be
Reduced To Small
Area.

Constantinople, Dec. 9.—(Havas Agency).—A peace treaty between Armenia and the Turkish Nationalists is reported to have been signed in Alexandropolis during the night of December 2-3. Under the treaty, Armenia's territory will be reduced to only the region of Erivan, the capital, and Lake Gokcha, excluding Kars and Alexandropolis.

The treaty provides that all Armenia's armaments must be delivered to the Turks, with the exception of 1,500 rifles, 25 quick-firers and three cannons, which the Armenians are permitted to keep. A Soviet administration has been organized in Erivan, according to the reports, and a simple accord exists between Soviet Russia, Azerbaijan, Armenia and the Turkish Nationalists.

TURKS ATTACK GREEKS.

London, Dec. 9.—The forces of Mustafa Kemal Pasha are attacking the Greeks at many points in Asia Minor, says a dispatch to the London Times from Smyrna. The dispatch adds that Gen. Papoulis, commander-in-chief of the Greek forces, accompanied by his staff, has left for the front.

ONTARIO WAGE BD. MAY ACT WITHOUT WORKER'S COMPLAINT

Recommendations May Be
Made To Government in
Near Future.

Toronto, Dec. 9.—Recommendations may soon be made to the Ontario Government, which, if accepted, will bring the minimum wage board of Ontario into action without having to wait for complaints from employees in a industry in the province.

Professor J. W. MacMillan, chairman of the board, stated today that the members were getting acquainted with one another, and also discussing the procedure of the board.

"Does not the act provide for the lieutenant-governor-in-council making regulations regarding the procedure of the board?" the chairman was asked. "Yes," he replied.

"All the members of the board suggest procedure to the council or make recommendations to the cabinet in this connection?"

"I think that will inevitably follow from our discussions. I cannot say anything further."

It appears from the wording of the act creating a minimum wage board that the board may automatically set itself in action to investigate wages and conditions in Ontario. It was thought by many at first that the board could not commence an investigation without a complaint from some employees in a particular employment.

LIBERAL EXECUTIVE MEETS AT OTTAWA

Will Discuss Organization
Matters—Prepare For
Coming Session.

Ottawa, Dec. 9.—(By Canadian Press).—A meeting of the National Liberal executive will be held here commencing at 11 o'clock tomorrow to consider matters in connection with organization and the approaching session of Parliament. Hon. William Lyon Mackenzie King and a number of his lieutenants will be in attendance. There was distributed from Liberal headquarters today a volume of considerable dimensions containing a full report of the proceedings of the National Liberal convention held at Ottawa on August 5, 6 and 7, 1919. It is a book of over 200 pages, covering everything that occurred in the convention hall during the three days the convention was in session.

WAR VETERANS FOR SELF-DETERMINATION LEAGUE, SAYS HEAD

President Lindsay Crawford
States Riotous Mob Not
Moncton "Citizens."

Toronto, Dec. 9.—(By Canadian Press).—Lindsay Crawford, national president of the Self-Determination League, has telegraphed to Canadian Press, Limited in reference to the recent demonstration against him at Moncton, N. B., that he did not say on that occasion that he was willing as a British subject to "kiss the flag."

Mr. Crawford says: "I was trying to explain to the mob that I was quite willing to kiss the Canadian flag, but my voice was drowned by noise."

"At all our meetings," says Mr. Crawford's message, "the Canadian flag is in evidence, but it is arrant nonsense to call Canadians 'Britishers.' It is equally ridiculous to label Moncton by describing a riotous mob of irresponsible youths as 'citizens.' Not five per cent of the mob were returned men and there were sixty returned men at the meeting as supporters of the Self-Determination League."

Mr. Crawford again asserts that the man who put the questions at the Moncton meeting was the "local Orange leader."

BELIEVE PASSAGE OF JOHNSON IMMIGRATION BILL IS NOW ASSURED

Preliminary Skirmish Favors
Supporters of Measure.

Washington, D. C., Dec. 9.—Supporters of the Johnson Bill to prohibit immigration into the United States for two years won every preliminary skirmish in the House of Representatives today with such ease that ultimate passage of the measure seemed to them to be assured.

Partisan lines disappeared during the debate. Representative Siegel, republican of New York, urged that "sufficient naturalization machinery be provided so that aliens may become citizens and receive encouragement in that direction." He said there were 75 points of entry along the Canadian border, and each had insufficient cler-

ical forces and examining physicians. Only 23 doctors were on duty on the entire border, he added.

Representative Hayden, Democrat of Arizona, said that he favored the bill, provided it was amended to allow the importation of Canadian and Mexican

labor to assist the farmers in crop harvesting.

London, Dec. 9.—The general strike in Spain has ended, according to the Exchange Telegraph's Madrid correspondent.

Calgary, Alta., Dec. 9.—Albert Smith, aged 63, dropped dead from heart disease here last night while watching a boxing bout.

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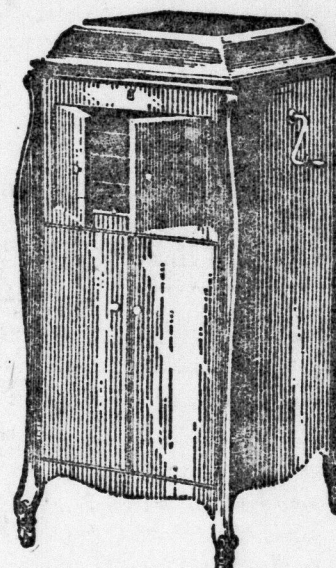
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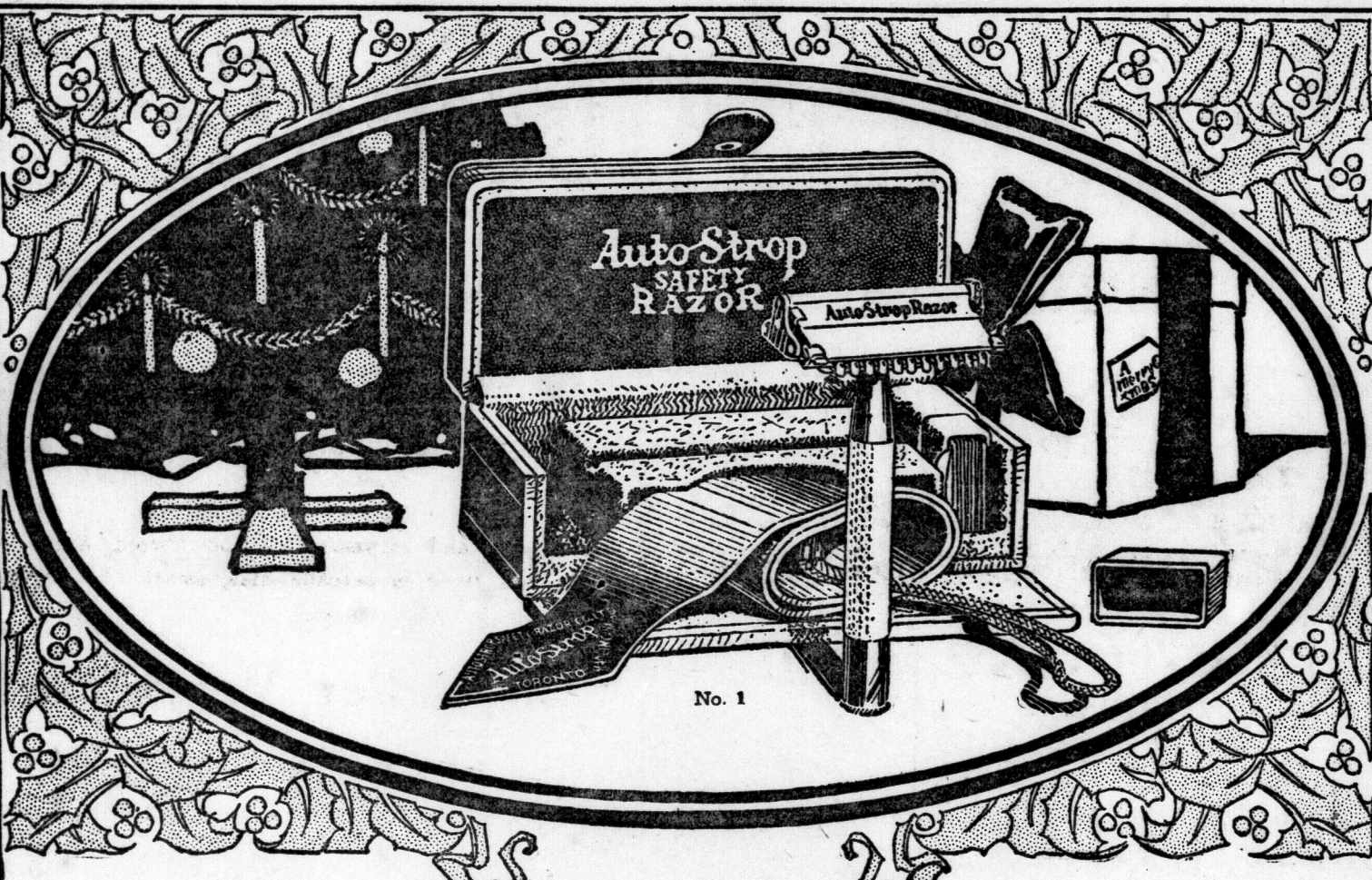
