Our market opened slightly lower than last night's close, and continued on its downward course until it touched 68% and 68%, a decline of 1½c from the opening. At the low point St.Louis was a good buyer, which was thought to be for Kaufman. New York also sent in some buying orders, Bradstreet's was out to-day with a decrease in the world's visible of 6,216,000 bushels. Kast_sof Rockies decreased 3,110,000 bushels, and Europe decreased 3,110,000 bushels, There was quite a number of weak longs shook out around 69c, which, we think, will put the market in a more healthy condition. The reports from the Northwest were more encouraging, as seeding is going on rapidly. San Francisco reported good rains throughout the State, which was a bearish factor. Weather in France is said to be more favorable, and we should judge this was so, as Paris sent many selling orders. Just as soon as the farmers get through seeding we think the country movement will increase wonderfully. There was good demand for cash wheat for milling, but the export enquiry was slow, and only a small amount worked. The trade to-day has been brisk and entirely of a local professional character. There is very little outside speculation, which is a bar to a substantial rise in wheat, but with any increase in this particular, prices would respond readily to statistical conditions.

Corn and oats—Ruled fairly active, and sympathized largely with wheat, declining about ¼ to ½c. The selling was chiefly by professionals, and commission people bought on the break moderately, but the markets did not respond very much. Receipts were 160 cars corn and 349 cars oats. The close was barely steady.

Provisions—Ruled dull and inactive, within a narrow range, with prices a little lower. Packers and professionals soid pork and lard, and c
