FAVORITES BEATEN IN FEATURES AT LANTONIA, LAUREL AND EMPIRE

SIR BARTON ONLY THIRD AT LAUREL

Starting at Odds-On, Finished
Behind Blazes and The
Porter.

Laurel, Md., Oct. 23.—Rai Parr's Blazes
today demonstrated that his new-found
staying power, in evidence the first time
a week ago when he won the Maryland
handicap, was not a flash in the pan,
but a permanent asset. He won the first
race of the afternoon by a mile, and
a good field at a mile. The light-
faced son of Wrack picked up 120
pounds in the last race, and in 17 4-5
he won by a length from E. B. Mc-
Lean's The Porter, which was an equal
distance in from J. K. Ross' Sir
Barton at the wire. L. Waterbury's
Sunnyside Park was beaten a nose by
Blazes in the third race, and the
Laurel was won \$7750 to the winner.
Blazes negotiated the mile in 1:40.
He was not as fast as he was in the
first mile and a quarter mapped out
for him in the Maryland, but he picked
up pounds from that race and con-
siderable weight to every one of his
opponents today with the exception of
The Porter. Blazes' performance was
in every way creditable in spite of
the fact that Jockey Jack O'Brien, who
had the mount on Sir Barton, did not do
the Star Shoot colt justice.

Coming from the outside position,
Johnston rushed the Parr colt off to a
lead of a length rounding the first turn,
but by the time the three-quarter pole
was reached Sir Barton had moved up
on the outside and raced thru the back
stretch with the son of Wrack. At the
half, which was reached in 17 4-5,
Blazes began to draw away as Sir Bar-
ton fell back and The Porter moved
with him under Suttell's urging to
dispute the issue with Blazes. The Por-
ter closed gamely under punishment,
but could never get within a length of
the winner, while Sir Barton just lasted
to stall off the rush of Sunnings Park.
Blazes paid \$14.20. Sir Barton was an
odds-on favorite.

CLEOPATRA LOOKS
NEXT TO MAN O' WAR
Lantonia, Ky., Oct. 23.—W. R. Coe's
sterling filly, Cleopatra, daughter of
Corycora—Gallic, triumphed over the
highest-rated three-year-old colts in this
country, excepting Man o' War, and
scored, in such fashion as to leave no
room for doubt as to her superiority, par-
ticularly over a distance. Her achieve-
ment was a noteworthy one, for, in ad-
dition to scoring in hollow fashion, she
clipped two and four-fifths from the
former track record, and came within two-
fifths of a second of equalling the Ameri-
can record for the distance, made at Sa-
ragosa this season by Exterminator, to
whom she finished second. On Watch,
winner of the Kentucky Derby, was also
landed in second place, and Damask,
carrying the Harry Payne Whitney colt
title, finished in third place.

John P. Grier, with Best Pal, the other
