ROBBERY OF \$1,338 PAYROLL. Two Officials of Silk Mill Held Up Near Jersey City Plant.

New York, Aug. 18—Superintendent Alfred Ecker and Examiner Charles Paltot of the Palanz Silk Mills, 111 Irving street, Jersey City, were robbed of \$1,338.15 in cash when they were returning from the Merchants' National Bank, Central avenue and Dovers street, with the company's payroll.

According to Ecker, when they were on Irving street, about fifty yards from the mill, two men stepped from behind a dilapidated car and, pointing a pistol at the superintendent, ordered him to drop the satchel.
