"I, G 51234 I/Cpl. MacKenzie, M., Section NCO in Trained Soldier Coy., called the roll from Reveille 21st May 1942 to tattoo 24th May 1942, and at reveille 25th and 26th of May 1942. The accused, C 2927 Spr. McIntyre, did not answer his name at any of these roll calls and could not be found. This concludes my evidence." my evidence." The accused declined to cross examine the witness. A-57898 L/Cpl. Nixon, R.C.E., (A5) C.E.T.C., C.A., Petawawa Military Camp, having been duly sworn SECOND WITNESS "I, A-57898 L/Cpl. Nixon, Section NCO in Trained Sobdier Coy., called the roll from reveille 5th June 1942 to tattoo 11th June 1942. The accused, C-2927 Spr. McIntyre, did not enswer his name at any of these roll calls and could not be found.

This concludes my evidence". f/Cal Nixon & G. The accused declines to question the witness. Record of the Declaration of a Court of Inquiry assembled at Petawawa Military Camp on the 19th day of June 1942 for the purpose of investigating and recording the absence without leave from his EXHIBIT "B" duty and deficiency, if any, in the Arms, Ammunition, Equipment, Instruments, Regimental Necessaries, or Clothing of No. C-2927 Spr.
