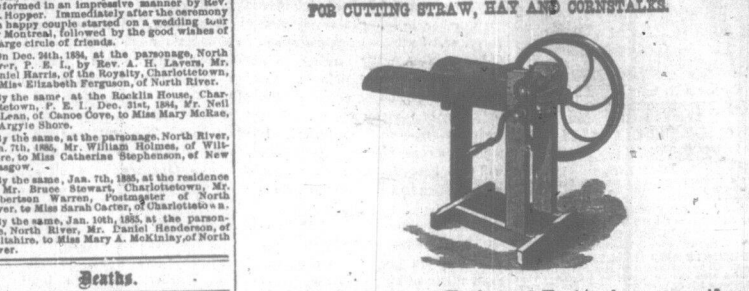
Deaths. At Springfield, on 6th of December, Flora Mason, aged seven years, only daughter of William Albert and Louisa Mason.
