Balance from 1887-88, not required. *b.* Balance from 1887-88, not required, and 9 Brigade Majors estimated for, only 8 paid. *c.* Under expenditure on these 3 items, \$31,534.65, represents articles of equipment and military stores ordered, but not received in time to be included in this year's accounts. *d.* Grant not sufficient. *e.* Caused by excess of Militia drilled for 1888-89. *f.* Not used. *g.* Guns ordered, not delivered. *h.* Actual expenditure, \$75,616.88,—less subscriptions by cadets credited to the account, \$24,379.96. *i.* Caused by balance for 1887-88, and \$40,000 estimated for Cavalry School at Toronto, not established. *j.* Urgent and necessary repairs, not anticipated.
