On motion of the Honorable Mr. Simpson, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Leonard, it was

Ordered, That the said Reports be taken into consideration by the House on Thursday next.

The Order of the Day being read for putting the House into a Committee of the Whole on the Bill intituled, "An Act to further amend the Act respecting fishing by foreign "vessels."

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Mitchell, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Campbell, it was

Ordered, That the same be postponed until to-morrow.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day the House was adjourned during pleasure and put into a Committee of the Whole on the Bill intitled "An Act to make further provision "for the Government of the North West Territories."

After some time the House was resumed, and

The Honorable Mr. Botsford, from the said Committee, reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same, with several amendments which he was ready to submit whenever the House would be pleased to receive them.

Ordered, That the Report be now received, and

The said amendments were then read by the Clerk.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Campbell, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Mitchell, it was

Ordered, That the said amendments be taken into consideration by the House to-morrow.

Then on motion of the Honorable Mr. Campbell, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Mitchell,

The House adjourned.
