## BILL.

An Act to repeal the Tonnage Dues imposed for defraying the expenses of maintaining Lighthouses and for other purposes connected with the Navigation of the waters of this Province, and to provide for the payment of such expenses out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS it is expedient to relieve the trade of Preamble. this Province from the tonnage dues imposed for the maintenance of Light Houses, Lights, Beacons, Buoys and for other purposes connected with the navigation of the 5 River St. Lawrence and other waters in this Province:

Be it therefore enacted, &c.,
