Penalty on failure tocomply with provisions of this Act.

Any person contravening the provisions of this Act, and engageing persons to go to foreign countries without having complied with the formalities above prescribed, shall be liable to a fine of \$200 for each person whom he shall have engaged, of which said fine one moiety shall belong to the informer, and the other moiety to the Crown; the offender may, moreover, be condemned to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, and any person who shall give any public notice, with the view of effecting engagements as above mentioned, without having obtained permission from the Mayor or Reeve, as hereinbefore required, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding dollars for 10 every such notice.

Foreign enlistment.

8. Nothing in this Act shall alter or affect the laws now in force respecting military enlistments for foreign countries.
