wa River, ascending the same to its head in Lake Tamiscamingne; and shall comprehend the Isles Perrot and Bizarre, and all the other Islands in the Rivers Saint Lawrence and Ottawa, nearest to the said County, and in the whole or in part fronting the same, excepting the Islands of Jesus and Montreal. The County of Effingham shall be bounded on the south-west by the north-east boundary line of the County of York, as last above mentioned; on the north-east by the south-west boundary line of the County of Leiuster, and shall comprehend the Island and Seigniory of Isle Jesus.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Districts in this Province. herein-after mentioned, shall be known, described, bounded and limited as herein-after described, that is to say, such part of the District of Quebec as lies on the south side of the River St. Lawrence, shall be bounded on the south west, by a line to commence at the River St. Lawrence on the north-easterly boundary of the Seigniory of St. Pierre des Becquets as heretofore established, and running from thence, along the said line which divides the said Seigniory from the Seigniory of St. Jean Deschaillons and its augmentation south-east to the depths of the said Seigniories, and thence still continuing the same course to the River Bécancour, thence up and through the middle of the said River to the northerly angle of the Township of Stanfold, thence along the east bounds of the said Township to its most easterly angle, thence along the north-west bounds of the Township of Arthabaska to its intersection with the north-west outline of the Township of Halifax, thence along said line south-westerly to the westerly angle of the said Township of Halifax, thence along the north east bounds of the Township of Chester, south-easterly to the most easterly angle of the said Township, thence north-easterly along the north-west outline of the Township of Wolfstown to the most northerly angle of the said Township: thence south-eastward along the south-west bounds of the Township of Ireland to the most south-easterly angle of the said Township of Ireland, north angle of the Township of Gorthly and westerly angle of the Township of Colraine, thence along the division line between the said last mentioned Township south-easterly to the extremity of the said line, thence between the Townships of Stratford and Winslow, Hampden and Gayhurst to the River Chaudière, thence up the middle of the said River to Lake Megantie, thence south-eastward through the middle of the said Lake, to the mouth of the River Arnold, thence up and through the middle of
