I gave them a Hog & some Flow, There told them the danger They were in coming to York, for the small Pose was in almost every house, They were much along = med I said they would not go to town I then sent my son to the bommanding Officer requesting him to have the goodness to come to my house that we might leaven their bufiness the same night
