Sir, I am desired by Mr Jarvis to call
your attention to his letter to you of the 20 January
in which he requests you to obtain Copies of accounts
of the I. D. of M. for the 2 years ~~ending~~ ^{long time since}
between the 1 April to the 30 October 1840.

Mr Jarvis received a letter from the
Comd. Genl. asking what Accounts were
wanted, and he explained that the ~~above~~
2 yearly Accounts regularly transmitted to this
Department had been lost and requested Copies thereof.

These Copies have not been received; the
Government has called for a statement of the
Indian funds; it is impossible to bring up and
balance the books until the missing Accounts
are forwarded, and Mr Jarvis will feel obliged by
your urging the Comd. Genl. to transmit them to the Office
without delay. —
