of the ratepayers, as the same appears by the latest return of said valuation on file in the office of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer at Fredericton, and shall lay such estimate and apportionment before the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council for approval.

- 4. The Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council may approve of said estimate and apportionment, or may vary either or both, as may seem just and fair, and shall make an Order-in-Council accordingly.
- 5. A duly certified copy of said Order-in-Council shall be transmitted to each city and town clerk, and to the Secretary of each municipality in the province. The clerk of each city and town shall forthwith, on receipt of such Order-in-Council, direct a warrant to the assessors requiring them to assess and collect the amount so apportioned by said Order-in-Council, to be paid by such city or town, from the ratepayers thereof. The secretary of each municipality shall forthwith apportion the amount to be assessed and collected from each parish and direct a warrant to the assessors of each parish respectively requiring them to assess and collect the amount named in said warrant.
- 6. The treasurers of each city, town and municipality shall, from time to time, as the assessments are collected and paid in, transmit the same to the treasurer of the said "The Canadian Patriotic Fund" at Ottawa, to be used by it in carrying out the purposes of the said corporation, in respect to residents of this province.
- 7. The assessors for each city, town or parish shall assess the amount to be levied by them equally upon the real and personal estate and income subject to taxation in such city, town or parish, together with any real and personal
