With reference to your Annual Report for 1887, I beg to inform you that the Lt. Genl. approves of the suggestion contained therein that one of the Industrial Schools proposed to be established on the mainland of British Columbia be located on the North West Coast at Metlakatla. The amount available for the erection of the school building will be \$2,000, and for the board, clothing and tuition of twenty-five pupils about \$8250 annually.
