

I beg to inform you with regard to the foregoing that the Hon. the Privy Council has not yet taken action upon the report which was submitted to it on the 21st May 1890 in respect to the regulations referred to by you. And in order that you may have an opportunity to ^{time} revise these regulations and consider at the same time the remarks made on them by His Lordship Bishop Grandin, to whom a copy thereof was sent, I forward herewith a copy of the regulations submitted to Council, as revised by Bishop Grandin; and I have to request that you will, when you have considered the same, return that copy to me, with any additions or alterations that may occur to you to be now necessary; and your comments upon Bishop Grandin's suggestions.
