

Ottawa, 1st March, 1905.

With cheque.

Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 18th ultimo enclosing voucher No. 3067 amounting to \$72.00 for work performed by various Indians of your Agency in freighting 120 sacks flour from Qu'Appelle Station to Touchwood, and in reply I enclose herewith cheque No. 4184 for \$72.00 in order that you may pay the Indians interested. It is observed that you omitted in this case to forward a memorandum in duplicate giving the names of the Indians in question. Kindly transmit the same to the Department at as early a date as possible. I have also to request that in future you will be particular to see that such a memorandum accompanies all vouchers similar to that above mentioned.

Kindly obtain from the Indians their receipts in duplicate, one set of which you should forward with your cash-book return. The cheque number should be written on the receipts also on the cash-book return opposite the amount of the cheque.
