- 2 -As the Province is not prepared to surrender control of the foreshore for the benefit of the Indians, there would appear to be little object in attempting further to acquire title to the Islands. The Department of National Defence, Naval Services, holds a permit for the use of Goose Spit for 21 years from January 1st, 1940, renewable for a further period on terms to be agreed upon. The rental is \$150.00 per year. If the Navy were requested to transfer the Islands, it is expected that they would expect a transfer of Goose Spit free of rental.
