Rev. W. C. Young was the first settled pastor of Bluevale congregation. He was a faithful and untiring servant of the Master. He belonged to the old school and was a strict Sabbatarian. His ministry was characterized by a very faithful expounding of the word. He was born in Dumfriesshire, Scotland, and laid the foundation of Presbyterianism in Wroxeter, Brussels and Bluevale.
