Felix trembled at the thought of his sinful life, when he heard Paul preach; Festus thought Paul was beside himself; and Agrippa, also, was much impressed by what Paul said.

655. Where was Paul sent from Cæsarea?

At his own request, Paul was sent from Cæsarea to Rome, to be tried before the Roman emperor, Nero.

656. What happened to Paul on his way to Rome?

When Paul was on his way to Rome, a great storm arose, and he was shipwrecked near the island of Malta.

657. What was done with Paul in Rome?

Paul was kept a prisoner in Rome for about two years; then he was set free, but was afterwards taken back to Rome, where, after a short imprisonment, he was put to death.

THE EPISTLES.

658. In what other way besides preaching did the apostles teach about Jesus Christ?

The apostles wrote letters to the churches, to teach them more about Jesus Christ.

659. What are the letters called, which the apostles wrote to the churches?

The letters which the apostles wrote to the churches are called epistles.

660. Who wrote most of these letters, or epistles, to churches?

Most of the letters to the churches were written by the apostle Paul.

661. Which of Paul's letters did he write first?

The first letters which Paul wrote to the churches, were the two epistles to the Thessalonians.
