

offending shall forfeit is, for each such neglect, to be immediately paid into the hands of the Treasurer, or at the discretion of the W. Master—the forfeit to be accumulative in the same proportion with the continued detention of such property.

XXIII.—The Lodge shall communicate regularly with the Grand Lodge immediately after the first Meeting next following the anniversary in each year, when a return of its subscribing Members (according to prescribed form) shall be transmitted, together with the quarterly dues, registering fees, and the amount required for Grand Lodge Certificates for the newly-made Brethren. Similar returns shall be made to the Provincial Grand Secretary, when called for; nevertheless, these communications may be made oftener to the Grand Lodge should occasion require.

XXIV.—The Members of the Lodge shall hold a Masonic Festival on the third Tuesday in the month of February, in every year, or at such other time as a majority of the Members in open Lodge shall determine, and which shall be dedicated to Brotherly Love and Refreshment, and to which any regular and approved Mason may have access on providing himself with a ticket.
