HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lambi in Manticalo or the Northwest Territories, excepting 8 and 25, which has not been homestcaded, or reserved to provide wood lots for settlers, or for other purposes, may be also been do for a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter sec-tion of 169 acres, more or less.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District in which the land to be taken in situate, or if the homesteder desires he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipeg, or the Local Agent for the district in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make entry for linu. A few of 3th is charged for a homested entry

HOMESTEAD DUTIES.

A settler who has been granted an entry for a homestead is required by the provisions of the Dominion Lands Act and the amendments thereto to perform the conditions connected herewith, under one of the following plant:

At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.

(2) If the father for mother, if the father is deceased) or any person who is eligible to make a homestead entry upon the provisions of this a homestead entry upon the vicinity of title land entered for by such the vicinity of title land entered for by such this Act as to re-sidence prior to obtaining patent may be satisfied by such person residing with the father

(3) If a settler has obtained a patent for his homestead, or a certificate for the issue of such patent countersigned in themanner pre-scribed by this Act, and has obtained entry for a second homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the first homestead, if the second homestead is in the vicinity of the first homestead.

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his household, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

The term "vicinity" used above is meant o indicate the same township or an adjoining reornering township.

A settler who avails himself of the provisions of Clauses (2) (3) or (4) must cultivate 30 acres of his homestead, or substitute 20 head of stock, with buildings for their accommodation, and have besides 80 acres substantially fenced.

Every homesteader who fails to comply with ne requirements of the homesteader law is able to have his entry cancelled, and the land lay be again thrown open for entry.

APPLICATION FOR PATENT

Should be made at the end of the three years before the Lecal Agent, Sub-Agent or the tion for patent the settler must give six mention notice in writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa of his intention to do so.

INFORMATION

Newly arrived immigrants will receive at the Immigration Office in Winnipeg, or at any Dominion Lands Office in Manitobs or the North-west Territories information as to the lands that are open for entry, and from the officurs in charge, free of expense, advice and assistance in necuring lands to suft thom.
