These are both rapid growers. As a tree adapted to supply fuel and posts, Mr. Caldwell recommends the Russian Golden Willow. It is a rapid grower, and there is more lasting quality to its timber, both for fuel and the purpose of fence posts. Evergreens are also making good progress, and the hardiest fruits, such as the Hybernal apple, the Transcendent crab, several varieties of plums, and the smaller fruits, are all giving a good account of themselves.

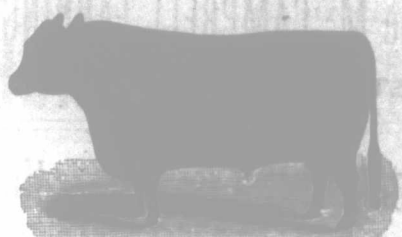
