At the age of eighty-one Mr. James Pollitt is still a chorister at Newton Heath, Lancashire. When eight years of age he became an alto boy at Culcheth Old School, Newton Heath, and with the exception of one year, spent at Accrington, he has continued to attend the church at the Sunday services, the festivals, and the week-night rehearsals.
From the report of the Executive Council for the restoration of Peterborough Cathedral, it appears that the expenditure upon the fabric has amounted to £53,614 8s. 10d., and of this amount the sum of £57 10s. 10d. has still yet to be raised. In addition, the special gifts for adorning and beautifying the interior of the cathedral, including the choir, floor, and fittings, have, so far as can be ascertained, cost upwards of £20,000.
