# **MILITARY SERVICE ACT 1917**

For the Attention of Class One Men

The location of The Exemption Tribunals in this district is as follows:—

Tribunal N. S. No. 63--Wolfville Tribunal N. S. No. 53--Windsor

These Tribunals will commence to deal with claims for exemption on November 8th.

All claims for exemption must be made not later than November 10th. Those who make or have made their claim for exemp-tion in writing through the Post Office will receive notice by registered letter of date on which their claim will be dealt with.

hose who neglect to make use of the Post Office must resent themselves in person at a Tribunal on November th, 9th or 10th, and they will then be informed as to when their claims will be dealt with

Severe penalties are provided by law for failure to report for service or claim exemption as above.
