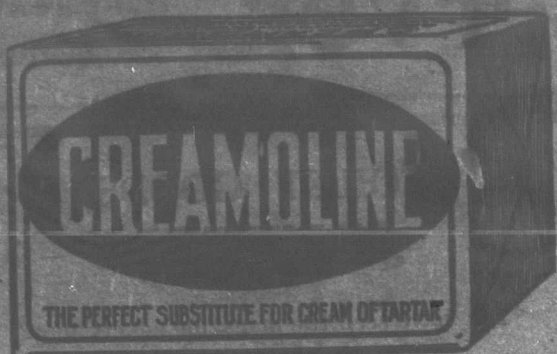

The election of conference officers resulted as follows: Clara Glenn, Grand Falls, grand pretor; Douglas McLean, Plaster Rock, vice pretor; Lorne Britton, Hartland, scribe.

On Saturday meetings were held at 9 and at 1:30 o'clock. During the afternoon an educational picture was put on for the boys in McLaren's Theatre. 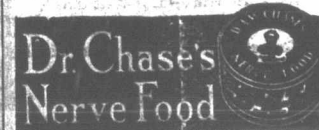
