MAP OF THE WORLD On Prof. Penck's Scale Discussed at the cographical Congress.

London, July 30 -- The sixth annual International Geographical Congress opened its fourth day's session in the great hall of the Imperial Lastitute at 10 o'clock this morning. The chief subject of discussiva were the reports upon Prof. Perwik's proposed map of the world on the scale of one to one million. Comprised in these reports were the report of the committee appointed at Berne, and the report of MM. Fabry and Leotard for the Geographical Society of Marseilles. The reading of the reports occupied some time, owing to their exhaustive character, and the ensuing discussion was decidedly animated.

The French delegates called attention to the fact that England's foot to an inch measurement was a great hindrance to the adoption of Prof. Penck's plan, and urged that it was most desirable that the metrical system should be generally adopted. The discussion was carried on in the English, French and German languages, and the debate was finally post-

poned until another occasion. Dr. W. Libby, jr., of New York, read paper on "The Relations of the Gulf Stream and the Labrador Current." The Prince of Monaco, who is nov conducting researches in the Atlantic Ocean on board his steam yacht Princess Alice, sent a paper recounting the results of his previous scientific cruises, which was read.

THE SEIZURE OF TRINIDAD.

Peixoto Had Intended to Present the Island to the U.S. London, July 30.-The Chronicle claims to have authority to deny the statement that Great Britain has aban-doned her occupation of the Island of

Trinidad. New York, July 30.—The Herald's special from Buenos Ayres says: Rid Janeiro advices state that indignaion meetings in protest against the seizur of Trinidad by England continue. The are not confined to Rio Janeiro, but are being held in all parts of the country. The police on Sunday night found it difficult to disperse the great crowds which gathered in the public thoroughfares in Rio Janeiro.

The correspondent says it is reported that among the late Gen. Pelxoto's papers have been found documents of-fering Trinidad to the United States. The late President, as these documents are said to show, also offered Amapa to France, and various lands on the Amazon to Italy, if these countries would guarantee non-recognition of the rebels in the late revolution.

TIN PLATE AT ROCK-BOTTOM. American Competition Alleged To B Affecting the Trade in Wales.

Washington, July 30 .- Consul How ells, at Cardiff, in a report to the Department of State on the tin-plate trade of South Wales, says it is emerging from a crisis which reached ar acute stage on the 1st of July, when 28 days' notice to terminate contracts and work was consequently suspended in nearly all the mills. The men demanded a restoration of the wages of 1874. For months a great deal of anxiety was experienced by both masters and men because of American competition, to which the fall in prices and the consequent reduction of wages and the stoppage of a large number of mills were attributed. The representatives of labor claimed that it was ridiculous to impoverish everybody interested in the trade, "to make a present of thousands of pounds to Americans on plates that they cannot make themselves, but will continue to take from Wales.' A board was appoined and settled the matter by adopting thescale of 1874, an increase of from 10 to 22 1-2 per cent on the existing wages.

'The lesson," Mr. Howells says, "has evidently been taken deeply to heart, that it was worse than useless to attempt to prevent American competition and whatever effect the restoration of the 1874 list may have upon the demand for plates, it must necessarily produce an improvement of prices; and in the interests of the immense number of operatives who have at times been brought to the verge of starvation it is to be hoped that the list will remain in operation for many years." Continuing, he says that the price current is believed to be at its lowest ebb, the latest figures being \$17.60 per




