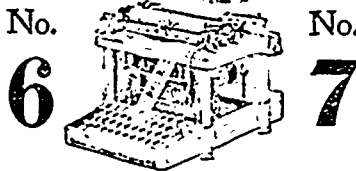

A TIN MINE IN SILK DRESSES.

It will, perhaps, be startling news to many who "walk in silk attire" that they carry about with them tin in more paying quantities than many a Cornish mine. This strange discovery is due to an English analyst, Dr. Phipson, to whom a silk dress was recently sent for analysis. He found that the silk in the dress contained water, 11.13 per cent.; ash (largely composed of oxide of tin and silica) 11.50; real silk, 28.14; and organic matters, etc., 16.13 per cent. It may be some consolation to the wearers, when their dresses are "worn out" at the end of three months, that they may recoup themselves to a slight extent by extracting the tin from the debris.—*Scraps.*
