It measures 2 yds. and 16 in. at the lower edge. The May Manton pattern of the blouse is cut in sizes from 34 to 42 in. bust measure and of the skirt, from 24 to 32 in. waist measure. The Empire gown 8522A shows a three piece skirt. It is closed at the back and back closings are being exploited on many back closings are being exploited on many of the newest designs.
