



On the entry into force of the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania on Trade and Commerce, the Agreement between the British and Lithuanian Governments respecting Commercial Relations, concluded at Riga and Kaunas on May 6, 1922, certain provisions of which were extended to trade relations between Canada and Lithuania on September 15, 1928, shall cease to have effect between Canada and the Republic of Lithuania.

In witness whereof, the undersigned, being duly authorized, thereto by their respective Governments have signed this Protocol.

Done in duplicate at *Vilnius* this *8* day of *August*, 1994, in the English, French and Lithuanian languages, each text being equally authentic.
