In a table format is provides a guide to these codes and labels according to their standard-building characteristics (ie, reflect ILO conventions, address essues of Wiges, hou s of work) and governmente structure and monitoring tradmers (ie, includes at least two of NGO/uniondulatry representatives, MGO address times participation in monitoring and verifying Tandard compliance). The document does not offer any analysis of these codes and labels brack on their strengths and weaknesses.
