

Reply of the Deputy Secretary General

Mr. Minister:

It affords me great pleasure to receive the letter of
Greeting by which the President of the Republic of the United
States of Brazil associates you as Survey Extraordinary and
Minister Plenipotentiary to Canada, and I extend to you, on
behalf of the people of Canada, a very cordial welcome.

your distinguished predecessor, Mr. Louis Albert King, C.
