After further Debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion; it was agreed to.

On motion of Mr. Bennett, the said Address was ordered to be engrossed and to be presented to His Excellency the Governor General by such Members of this House as are of the Honourable the Privy Council.

On motion of Mr. Bennett, it was resolved, That this House will, on Thursday next, resolve itself into a Committee to consider of the Ways and Means for raising the Supply to be granted to His Majesty.

On motion of Mr. Bennett, Armand LaVergne, Esquire, Member for the Electoral District of Montmagny, was appointed Chairman of Committees of the Whole House.

The House then adjourned at 10.10 o'clock, p.m., until to-morrow, at 3 o'clock, p.m.
