PRAYERS.

By unanimous consent, on motion of Mr. Pickersgill, seconded by Mr. Laing, it was ordered,—That the subjects dealt with in Bills C-83 and C-84 be referred to the Standing Committee on Mines, Forests and Waters for consideration; provided, however, that despite this Motion the said Bills shall remain on the Order Paper as Orders for second reading without prejudice to the right to make or proceed with Motions for such second reading.

On motion of Mr. Rinfret, seconded by Mr. Caron, it was ordered,—That the name of Mr. Foy be substituted for that of Mr. Richard on the Standing Committee on Railways, Canals and Telegraph Lines.

By unanimous consent, on motion of Mr. Knowles, seconded by Mr. Fisher, it was ordered,—That the name of Mr. Howard be substituted for that of Mr. Herridge on the Standing Committee on Mines, Forests and Waters.
