the \$10 fee is charged to all Canadians whether or not they are members of the legal profession. The hon. member and myself have in common the fact that we are not members of the legal profession, nor do I suspect either one of us would want to be. But if I wished to buy one of these books I can see no justification why I should pay any more than my colleague who sits next to me in the House of Commons.

I think the hon. member is to be congratulated, as is the Auditor General, for bringing this matter to the attention of the

house. I will urge on the Minister of Industry (Mr. Drury), under whose jurisdiction the department of printing now falls, that this situation be rectified immediately. Obviously, from the hon. member's research, it is too late to do anything this year, but I am certain we would all take a dim view if it was not made known by November 1 this year that the price of these documents will be \$10 to all Canadians, whether or not they are members of the legal profession.

Motion agreed to and the house adjourned at 10.36 p.m.
