RENTAL HOUSING

Question No. 677—**Mr. Gleave:**

1. How much money is being contributed by each of the following toward the 65-unit low-rental housing project in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan (a) the federal government (b) the provincial government (c) the City of Prince Albert, Saskatchewan?
2. What amount was paid for the land involved?

Hon. Robert K. Andras (Minister without Portfolio):

1. (a) Central Mortgage and Housing approved a loan of \$554,040 in December, 1970, under Section 16 of the National Housing Act to assist in the financing of a low-rental housing project in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan, the loan being repayable over a term of 50 years at an interest rate of 7½ per cent.

2. Since this low-rental project is privately sponsored, information with respect to the purchase price of the land is not available.
