| Standing Committees                          |  |
| Library                                      | (a) The Joint Committee on the Library of Parliament to which shall be appointed seventeen senators.   |
| Printing                                     | (b) The Joint Committee on the Printing of Parliament to which shall be appointed twenty-one senators.   |
| Restaurant                                   | (c) The Joint Committee on the Restaurant of Parliament to which shall be appointed the Speaker and six other senators.  |
| Scrutiny of Regulations                      | (d) The Joint Committee on Scrutiny of Regulations to which shall be appointed eight senators.   |
| Official Languages                           | (e) The Joint Committee on Official Languages to which shall be appointed nine senators.   |
| Standing Rules and Orders                    | (f) The Committee on Standing Rules and Orders, composed of fifteen members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, which is empowered on its own initiative to propose to the Senate amendments to the rules from time to time.  |
| Internal Economy, Budgets and Administration | (g) The Committee on Internal Economy, Budgets and Administration, composed of fifteen members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, which is authorized on its own initiative to consider all matters of a financial or administrative nature relating to the internal management of the Senate. |
