Agassiz has said, "If you study Nature in books, when you go out of doors you cannot find her;" so if you study disease only in lectures and text-books, when you go to the bedside you will not recognize it. Remember that the physician is a servant of Nature, never her master, and he only will rise in the service who can follow close in her footsteps, and successfully aid her in her struggle with disease.
