**THE TRUE STORY OF MY LIFE**: an Auto-biography by ALICE M. DIHL, Novelist, Writer, and Musician. Demy Svo. 10s. 6d. net.

**THE LIFE OF W. J. FOX**, Public Teacher and Social Reformer, 1786-1864. By the late RICHARD GARNETT, C.B., LL.D., concluded by EDWARD GAUNTLET. Demy Svo. (12 x 5 1/2 in. high.) 16s. net.

W. J. Fox was a prominent figure in public life from 1820 to 1860. From 1823 to 1840 he was M.P. for Oldham (1827-1828), and he still always remained friendly with that church. His Chapel, where his Ratcliffe Union turned a great反叛, was in constant contact with a number of other reformers, including Everett, Anthony, Robert Horne, and Harriet Martineau, among others. In 1832 Mr. Horne, Fox's teacher, had ready his "Avian Anti-Slavery Society," founded by the former, and once entered into the association. As a teacher, Fox was unconquerable in his desire to improve and to make of others a better class of people than he was of himself. Not only did he do much for the improvement of the slaves of the United States, but he also did much for the slaves of the United Kingdom, and for the slaves of Africa.
