**FAIR RECEIPTS AT MARKET
PRICES FOR CATTLE STEADY**

Prices Dull, But Sheep and Lamb
Brought Somewhat Better
Figures.

Receipts of live stock at the City Market

There were 85 carloads, composed of 1106 cattle, 560 hogs, 2537 sheep and lambs, with about 1000 head of calves.

The bulk of fat cattle offered were of good quality.

Traded in fat cattle, well as stockers and yearlings, but slow, and market was not so good.

Several of the drovers reporting as having lost money, having paid more in the country than they realized here for their cattle.

The drovers also report good to choice well-fleshed cattle as scarce in the country, and, and almost none to get.

Exporters.


There was little doing in the shipping class, excepting a few cows and bulls. Cows sold for \$2.50 and bulls at \$5.00 to \$5.75 per cow.

Butchers.

A very few light hogs sold at from \$4.25 to \$4.50; loads of good at \$3.70 to \$4.00 per cow, \$3.50 to \$3.75; medium at \$3.25 to \$3.50; and heavy at \$3.00 to \$3.25. The feeder, 82 to 100 lbs; canners, \$1.25 to \$1.75 per cwt.

Stockers and Feeders.

The demand for feeders was fair, but not so good as for stockers. Some buyers, farmers and dealers were on the market buying for feeders, but not so many. Some buyers 900 to 1200 lbs. each, for which they paid \$3.40 to \$3.75, and they were of good quality. Some buyers 1000 to 1200 lbs. for \$3.25 to \$3.50. Stockers sold at from \$2.25 to \$2.50.
